


Comprehensive Reports Make MI Write Easy to Use

Reports are the key to tracking student growth and knowing how to best use them is essential for every teacher. MI Write teachers have access to several useful reports at their fingertips to keep track of their students' progress throughout the year. They are broken down into categories (performance, prompts, usage, and progress) and each report displays a table and a graph.

Class Averages: Trait and Total Scores

The report below displays the average score for each writing trait, total score, and teacher-scored textual evidence and content accuracy categories by class and by student. The averages are calculated using the score from the most recent draft of each essay. To view a detailed performance report for a specific student, click the student's name.

Class data can also be organized by the prompts you enable to see how well these prompts are addressing the needs of your students. This is found in the **Prompts report**.

You can see a breakdown of how students are using the program on the **Usage report** which displays everything from total number of drafts to how much time they are spending in lessons.

With this idea of where students are spending their time, you can better assess the effectiveness of MI Write in your classroom. Used in conjunction with the Performance reports, you will be able to understand why your students are performing the way they are.
